Sea to Sky Corridor

Starting in Richmond, your journey will take you through Vancouver and over the Lions Gate bridge where spectacular views of the mountains including Cypress will take your breath away. The drive continues from West Vancouver and follows the awe-inspiring pacific coastline with wide open views of Howe Sound and its mountainous islands, then ascends past rushing waterfalls and emerald lakes through old-growth valleys surrounded by rugged peaks.
